Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit-262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0245) with intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder with respect to appeal dated 12.11.2024 -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the **Principal of Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit- 262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0245) dated 12.11.2024** to the commission in respect to Conditional Permission with seat reduction issued to **Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit- 262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0245) with intake capacity of 30 seats (38 seats including EWS) [instead of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS)] in UG (BAMS) course and 06 seats (08 seats including EWS) in 01 PG course in the subject namely Dravyaguna Vigyana** due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in **Conditional Permission with seat reduction** letter of even no. dated 03.08.2024.
- Thereafter, the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the hearing letter was issued to the **Principal, Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit- 262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0245)** vide Commission's letter **Ref. No. NCISM/Comm/OPT Appeal/(2024-25)- (UP) dated 19.11.2024** to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on **20.11.2024** in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the Conditional Permission with seat reduction letter of even no. dated 03.08.2024 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on **20.11.2024** and on behalf of the college, **Prof. SS Bedar, Principal of the college and Dr. Dibyabh, Reader in RSBK and Dr. Ramesh Gupta, Lecturer, RSBK** of the College attended the hearing.
- The hearing committee sought clarification from **Prof. SS Bedar, Dr. Dibyabh, Reader in RSBK and Dr. Ramesh Gupta, Lecturer, RSBK** of the College regarding shortcomings mentioned in the Conditional Permission seat reduction letter of even no. dated 03.08.2024 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM and observation made by the hearing committee are as under:-

They maintain in online software HMIS. d) Shalya and Panchkarma consultant were not available in hospital. e) Vaccination facility is not available since 2020. f) Canteen/mess is not available in hospital and hostel mess is temporary closed. g) Cadaver is not available in the college. h) Ambulance is not working. i) OPD & IPD Central Register data mismatched due to not reported & not registered patient entries not made properly. j) Panchkarma procedure numbers were not entered properly as multiple procedure for single patients written once only. 4. The submission made by the **Principal of the college and** observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to consider the appeal on the basis of an **affidavit submitted by Manvendra Singh, Director General, AYUSH Department, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh vide certificate No. 1781/2522/24 dated 25.10.2024** wherein it is mentioned that the shortcomings/deficiencies will be fulfilled at the earliest for Grant of conditional permission to **Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit- 262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: AYU0245) as per the concerned acts & regulations.**
5. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM **vide letter no. NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2024-25)-(UP) dated 25.11.2024** to grant conditional permission to **Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit- 262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: AYU0245) with intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 as per the concerned acts & regulations.
6. **It is also hereby informed that the status of permitted seats for PG course remains the same as mentioned in our office letter of even no. dated 03.08.2024.**
7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above, conditional permission is issued to **Lalit Hari State P.G. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Pilibhit- 262001, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID: AYU0245) with intake capacity of 50 seats (63 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course in the subject namely Dravyaguna for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
 - (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats** of the permitted intake capacity of **50 seats (63 seats including EWS)** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
9. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

11. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26 as per rules:**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
12. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
